**STANDING RULES**

**Rule 1: Name**

The Club name was changed to Brevard Federated Republican Women (BFRW) per NFRW Charter of February 8, 2012.

**Rule 2: Membership/Dues**

- A. Membership dues in the BFRW shall be \$50.00 for new primary BFRW members, and renewing membership shall be \$45.00 paid annually. New memberships are those who were not members during the previous year.
- B. New Associate memberships shall be \$50.00, and renewing Associate memberships shall be \$45.00 paid annually.
- C. New and renewal primary BFRW members who are Veterans shall pay \$30.00 annually.
- D. The Club membership roster may be shared, as the position requires, with the permission of the Club President, and upon receipt of a signed "Conflict of Interest Policy."

**Rules 3: Elections**

To be eligible for election to the BFRW Executive Board, the member must be a member in good standing, have attended a majority (6+1) of the current year's general meetings, and have served as an active participant in a committee or chaired a committee for a minimum of six months.

**Rule 4: Travel Compensation**

- A. BFRW pays the hotel, transportation, and registration for the President to attend FFRW Board meetings and conventions.
- B. BFRW pays the hotel, transportation, and registration for the Treasurer to attend FFRW Board meetings and conventions.
- C. BFRW will pay a monthly President's allowance of \$25.00 to help with travel expenses for her attendance at various political functions when representing the BFRW.

**Rule 5: Annual Appreciation Gift**

BFRW will present an annual appreciation gift of \$50.00 to the President at the December BFRW membership meeting.

**Rule 6: Memorial Gift**

BFRW will make a memorial acknowledgement gift in the event of the death of a member or a member's spouse, in their honor.

**Rule 7: Finance**

Subject to the availability of funds: BFRW Executive Committee may, in its discretion, choose those organizations the Club will support throughout the fiscal year. Members and organizations may, no less than 30-days prior to the beginning of the Club’s fiscal year, submit a proposal for financial or in-kind support.

**Rule 8: Executive Committee Meetings**

- A. Executive Committee meetings are held monthly at the call of the President.
- B. The President may open Executive Committee meetings to members of BFRW and members may attend those meetings in a non-voting capacity. Only those items on the Committee’s official agenda shall be discussed during an Executive Committee meeting.
- C. Agenda items must be submitted to the chair of the Executive Committee for review no less than five (5) days prior to the meeting.

**Rule 9: General Membership Meeting/Event Protocol**

No videos or voice recordings of meetings or BFRW events are to be made during the meeting or event without prior consent of the President or her appointed representative.

**Rule 10: Amendments**

These standing rules are not part of the Bylaws and may be amended at any meeting of the Executive Committee by a majority vote, provided that written notification of the proposed amendment(s) shall have been sent to each member of the Executive Committee with the call to the meeting.
