Republican Primary Civility Resolution



REPUBLICAN PRIMARY CIVILITY RESOLUTION

WHEREAS Brevard Federated Republican Women (“The Club”) believe that all Republicans must treat each other with respect and work together to advance President Donald J. Trump’s “Make America Great Again” mandate.

WHEREAS The Club believes in President Ronald R. Reagan’s eleventh commandment - Thou shalt not speak ill of any fellow Republican - and that Republican primary elections must focus on issues important to Republican voters.

WHEREAS The Club believes that discourteous and insolent Republican primary electioneering tactics do not embody Republican ideals and do not help Republicans win general elections.

WHEREAS The Club desires to boost Republican participation in the primaries to ensure that Republicans elect the best possible candidates to represent them in the general elections.

ACCORDINGLY, IT IS HEREBY, RESOLVED:

1. The Club denounces all kind and form of discourteous and insolent electioneering tactics directed to any Republican primary candidate.
2. The Club reserves the right to exclude any Republican primary candidate involved in or associated with discourteous and insolent electioneering tactics directed to their Republican primary rival(s).
3. The Club reserves the right to exclude any Republican primary candidate who will not publicly disavow discourteous and insolent attacks on their Republican primary rival(s) by person(s) or organization(s) not within their control.

House Bill 1205 is a comprehensive reform of the process for a citizen-led initiative to place a constitutional amendment on the ballot. The legislation was signed by the Governor on May 2nd, 2025 and went into effect immediately.

The bill intends to protect initiatives from the types of widespread fraud that the Office of Election Crimes and Security investigated during the last election. Specifically, the bill makes the following changes:

Requirements for Petition Sponsors

- Before collecting any signatures, a petition sponsor is required to submit affirmations to the Department of State that each person collecting or handling petitions is a US Citizen, FL resident, and is not a felon.
- Once a petition reaches 25% of the required signatures, a petition sponsor is required to submit a \$1,000,000 bond to the Department of State.
- An organization may only sponsor one petition at a time.

Verification of Signatures

- Petition forms must be delivered to a supervisor of elections in 10 days (Current law is 30 days).
- A supervisor of elections must notify an individual that they have signed a petition, and individuals will have an opportunity to revoke their signature.
- The bill requires initiative petitions to elicit additional identification information from voters signing the petition.

Election Violation Enforcement

- Increases existing fines and creates new criminal penalties for violations of the initiative petition process
- Violations of the Florida Election Code relating to irregularities or fraud involving issue petition activities are eligible for RICO charges.


