

U.S. Congressman

Congressman Haridopolos will speak about his legislative work and share insights into what is happening in Congress and our Nation's Capital.



Congressman Haridopolos began his career teaching U.S. History and Political Science at Brevard Community College—now Eastern Florida State College, and taught classes at the University of Florida.

Congressman Haridopolos Represented Brevard County in the Florida House of Representatives and the State Senate from 2000-2012, he championed transparency, reduced taxes, and advanced conservative reforms. When he was serving as President of the Senate from 2010-2012, he made transforming the Florida Senate into a more conservative policy body a key objective of his time in office.

He was elected to represent Florida's 8th Congressional District in 2024. BFRW is honored having Congressman Haridopolos as our MAGA Associate Member.

The recipient of the President's Points of Light Gold Volunteer Service award

Dorothy Walsh is a Certified Life Coach with a master's degree in psychology and bachelor's degree in human services. Dorothy is a veteran advocate and started her non-profit Their Voice of Hope. Through Their Voice of Hope Dorothy created several programs that assist female veterans who are dealing with PTSD. Programs including Healing Through Art Expression, fishing, day trips, and luncheons that promote socialization and give women a "safe space". She is the only civilian veteran mentor with Brevard Veterans Treatment Court helping female veterans work through their issues, many of which stem from sexual assault or domestic violence. Dorothy is a 45-year member of the American Legion Auxiliary, member of the VFW Auxiliary, and the BFRW.

In 2018 Dorothy started Brevard County Honors Veterans, Wreaths Across America program to work towards honoring all veterans buried in cemeteries throughout Brevard County. She has enrolled more than 30 cemeteries.

Dorothy has received numerous awards and recognition for her service but her most distinguished award was in 2020 when she received the President's Points of Light Gold Volunteer Service award from then-President Donald J. Trump.



Terri Nieves

I am a mom of three and grandmother to three. I have been married to the same man for 45 years.


