


Veterans Honor Roll

Immediate Past President

I was raised in the small town of Covington, Indiana—a place rooted in tradition and public service. My Aunt Cecil proudly served in Congress representing our hometown, followed by my Uncle John Meyers who took over the seat after her tenure. During his campaign, I had the unique opportunity to travel across Indiana's 7th District with my family, actively supporting his run for office.

I went on to attend Franklin College in Franklin, Indiana. In 1969, I married Ken Gentis and we moved to Northern Illinois, eventually settling in St. Charles where we raised our two daughters. During that time, I worked in the legal field for over 30 years.

Around 1998, Ken and I relocated to downtown Chicago, where I became involved in several Democratic campaigns and served as a Precinct Captain for the 1st Ward. Around 2010, I returned to the Republican Party and remained active in Chicago politics.

In 2014, we moved to Indian Harbour Beach, Florida. One of the highlights of that time was attending President Trump's 2016 Inaugural Ball—thanks to an invitation from Louise Patenge (Beth Young's sister). In February 2017, I joined my first Brevard Federated Republican Women (BFRW) meeting at the Duran Golf Club, again with Louise. Soon after, I began assisting Deanna and Debbie with their jewelry sales at events.

By December 2017, Beth invited me to the Executive Committee (EC) Planning Meeting, and in January I officially joined the EC as Corresponding Secretary. I proudly served in that role until 2021, when I became President of BFRW—a position I held through 2024. I am especially grateful to Beth Young for her guidance and mentorship over the years.

Serving as BFRW President for four years was a deeply rewarding chapter of my life. I thoroughly enjoyed attending BFRW, FFRW, and NFRW meetings and events—including

Ms. Goudelock was an independent voter in Florida until the 2008 Obama election. After being trained by Karen Fenske, Ms. Goudelock joined the Republican party. In 2010 she started the grassroots movement that changed Brevard County code for Backyard Chickens. In 2011, school closures prompted the founding of Brevard Parents Action Committee with a group of local parents. BPAC encouraged conservative and fiscally responsible individuals to run for school board. (our children are our most precious and important asset in this country) BPAC hosted the "Budget Basics" series that informed candidates and parents about responsible stewardship of funds and resources for schools. This work helped build the foundation for the ICOC – the Independent Citizens Oversight Committee which oversees how the 1/2 cent sales tax monies collected for education are spent. Currently, Ms. Goudelock is the vice chairman of the ICOC.

In 2018, Ms. Goudelock worked for the RPOF as the Regional Director for Rick Scott's Senatorial run, defeating long-term incumbent Bill Nelson. Ms. Goudelock remains active in supporting women who run for office particularly with fundraising and organizing or hosting events.

Ms. Goudelock is the proud mother of two girls Lydia and Carys who have constantly been the inspiration and focus of her every endeavor.

Ms. Goudelock has a BFA in art history, is an RPT in pharmacy and has her master's in Logistics and Supply Chain Management (2023). Ms. Goudelock resides in Cocoa
