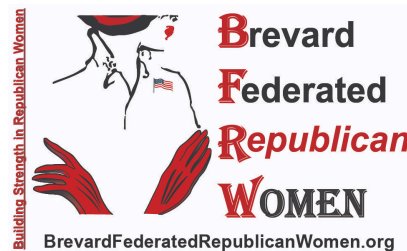

Legislative Committee



The 2026 Florida Legislature will be busy working on lots of issues this session. Bills that are being filed are to make homeownership more affordable and predictable for people across the state. Some of the proposals focus on cutting or eliminating non-school property taxes, giving seniors extra tax breaks, keeping property tax increases in check, making it easier to transfer Save Our Homes benefits, and offering incentives for things like insurance and flood-mitigation improvements.

Some bills that have been filed in the House of Representatives by those in the Brevard delegation are:

HB 1169-Enforcement of the Florida Building Code-Tramont

HB 1075-Municipal Utility Connections-Sirois

HB 1359-My Safe Florida Home Program-Hodgers

HB 1303-Department of Financial Services-Miller

HB 1553- Evidence of Damages to Prove or Rebut Medical Expenses in Personal Injury or Wrongful Death Actions-Brackett

Bills that have been filed in the 2026 Florida Senate as of 1-9-2026

S 1602 Housing for Veterans-Wright

It's important to note that these proposals are still evolving as they move through committee weeks and the legislative session. Amendments may be added, language can change, and new proposals may be introduced, so the final package may look different by the time bills are voted on or joint resolutions are sent to the ballot.

A bill (HB or SB) is voted on by the Legislature and becomes law when the governor signs it.
